Every Cross Has an Unanswered *Why*

1Chron. 19:10-13 Now when Joab saw that the battle was set against him in front and in the rear, he selected from all the choice men of Israel and they arrayed themselves against the Arameans.

But the remainder of the people he placed in the hand of Abshai his brother; and they arrayed themselves against the sons of Ammon.

He said, "If the Arameans are too strong for me, then you shall help me; but if the sons of Ammon are too strong for you, then I will help you. *Be strong*, and let us show ourselves *courageous* for the sake of our people and for the cities of our God; and *may the LORD do what is good in His sight.*" (NASB)

Have you ever felt like David—the battle is set against you from behind and in front and it feels like there is absolutely nothing you can do about it? I have and so did Job—he lost everything except a wife who encour-

aged him to curse God and die. Abraham—he was told he would be a father to a multitude only to find himself really old and childless. Moses—had to flee from his family only to be exiled on the backside of a desert for 40 years. Joshua—nothing behind him and giants before him. Mary, the mother of Jesus—pregnant by God Himself and no way to prove it. John the Baptist—lived his life in a desert only to be beheaded. Peter—proclaiming his love one minute only to deny the One he loved the next.

And Jesus—arrested, falsely accused, beaten, mocked, spit upon, hated by the very ones He came to save. He could have saved Himself, but chose not to because He knew if He didn't die we would.

He was hedged in by His enemies on all sides. He gave up everything except one thing: He never stopped loving—not mankind and not God.

Have you ever thought about His cry on the

cross, "Father, Father! *Why* have You forsaken Me?" May I paraphrase, "Daddy, Daddy, where are You? *Why* have You left Me? I did what You asked and You have forsaken me and I can't remember *why.*"

God is silent. Jesus does not falter, "Daddy, We've never been separated—NEVER. It sure does feel like You've left Me here alone. Nevertheless, I will still trust You—into Your hands I commit My Spirit!" Jesus entrusted His spirit into the arms of One He could not feel, see or perceive.

I personally believe the most painful part of Jesus' death was the fact that it felt like God had forsaken Him and He couldn't remember why.

Three weeks ago, our family suffered a painful blow. Our daughter Dana was home alone when suddenly her baby boy was born prematurely. Unable to get her phone, she held and sang to little Joshua Daniel. Her hus-



band, Joshua came home and called 911. Paramedics called for two life-flight helicopters, one for our grandson and the other for our daughter who was hemorrhaging. Dana made it to the hospital in time, but just minutes from the hospital baby Joshua grabbed Jesus' finger and didn't let go. The good news is he will never know pain, sorrow, hunger, injustice, rejection, tragedy, hardship or sin. The "bad" news is he left behind shattered hearts that are painfully aware of our loss.

There are times in life when nothing makes sense and all you can do is surround yourself with those who love you, gaze into the eyes of Perfect Love and breathe while your hearts cries out, "This doesn't make any sense, but this I know—You are good! My circumstances threaten to accuse You, but I know there is not even a shadow of cruelty in Your heart. Therefore, into Your hands I commit my life, my heart and my spirit and even...this precious life!"

Every cross has an unanswered why..



I believe that *everything* in life is meant to lead us to God. That means our past, present and future should take us deeper into the heart of God, which results in our walking into our destiny and purpose. As a child, I experienced physical and sexual abuse that nearly destroyed me spirit, soul and body...but for the grace of my God! I know how it feels, at a young age, to be used and abused sexually, but, thank God, I also know how it feels to experience the love and healing power of my heavenly Father who can put the most shattered life back together.

We thank God everyday for *Our Father's Farm*—a place where lost dreams can be found and shattered lives can be healed. God has clearly asked us to provide love and homes for girls who have been rescued from the horrible sex slave industry in America. We want to help as many girls as the Lord will send our way. We are in relationship with two well-established organizations who rescue these girls. I recently received a call from one of them saying they just rescued 110 girls (ages 6-14) and wanted to know if we had any housing for them. Unfortunately, we are full.

When God first invited us to partner with Him in loving these little lambs, my response was, "God, I need to know that we have what it takes to be able to help these girls." Two weeks later, He sent us a 13 year old girl who had been devastated by sexual abuse at a young age. This precious girl had received professional counseling for 7 years, but she was basically non-functioning. I've never met anyone as fractured as she. To God's glory, in less than six months of living on Our Father's Farm she is now functioning at a high level—she can eat, sleep, relate to others and go about her day without being paralyzed with fear or anxiety. She is in love with a very personal God. She now laughs, cries and feels every emotion. Her face and eyes beam with light and joy and energy! God is still in the process of healing her, but her progress is nothing short of miraculous.

After watching God encounter and heal her, I am able to say, "God, with You, we can do all things! We *can* help and bring healing to these shattered girls."

Now this is the part where you can help us! God has clearly invited us to provide homes and families for girls rescued from the sex slave industry and for others—and we want to do exactly that! We have already purchased (debt-free) the exterior materials needed for a *30,000 sq. foot building*. Before Al Siemens, who has generously volunteered to erect the structure can begin, we need the finances for the road, water, electric and 10,000 sq. foot basement. All of that will cost approximately \$110,000. Will you ***please pray*** and ask if you are to help us? Our team is praying diligently asking God to speak to *110* people who will donate at least *\$1000 this month*, which will provide the necessary funds. We have a short window to build here due to our weather—May through Nov.

What will we use this building for? We are glad you asked...

- Basement: multi-purpose room/storage
- Main Floor: 8 healing rooms, dorm for interns & others in need of intensive care, healing & discipleship, 300 person meeting room for seminars, church services, worship/prayer room and Apostolic Training School
- The crowing jewel is the third floor: This floor will be set aside for girls rescued from human trafficking and other children and young women in crisis.

You may or may not be in a position to financially donate, but please pray for us, for prayer changes things! God told me once that *everyone can do something*—I've never forgotten that.
