Too Young To Understand

Too young to be a mother and too young at age 13 to even understand, Susie's mother takes her for her third abortion.

Terrified, she lay on the table shaking and crying. A nurse, seeing her tears, talked in a hateful way to her, treating her like nothing more than an object. Why is the nurse so angry? Susie wondered.

She dreaded what she knew was about to happen because she'd been here twice before when she was eleven.

The doctor walked into the cold, tomb-like room and paralyzing fear gripped her. Time stood still in the little girl's heart and mind as the doctor did what he had come to do.

A short time later, Susie was taken home by her mother who was a stranger to her. There were no words of comfort, no expressions of kindness, no one to help her process what had just been done and no one to

protect her from future violation.

Three decades later, the suffocating memories still haunt her—not because she hasn't tried to forget. As a matter of fact, she's tried very hard. She tried counseling, prayer, special groups for abortion survivors, but nothing stopped the silent screams in her heart and mind. Nothing would fill the grand canyon of emptiness that consumed her soul. Her pain, guilt, shame and immense loss clung to her like a wet, cold blanket draining the life out of her.

With each passing year, her torment only grew. Well meaning friends encouraged her to put the past behind her—she wished she could!

How could this happen to an innocent child? When Susie was just two, her mother left. Her father worked nights. It wasn't long before her father left her home alone at night. Terrified of being alone at night, at age eleven, a neighborhood

teen-ager offered to stay with her. Too young to know better and too young to understand, her nightmare began. This young man took advantage of this innocent child. His actions resulted in a lifetime of torment for Susie. After becoming pregnant for the third time, Susie's mother took her to live with her.

Thank God Susie's story doesn't end there. After hearing about what God is doing on Our Father's Farm, Susie came for healing.

We began with a prayer and a blessing. Susie then consecrated her imagination to God and asked Him to come. The suffocating pain, which had become her constant companion, rushed to the surface. I invited Susie to tell her heavenly Father what had happened to her and how she felt. A vivid memory came up—she saw herself in that awful room. Her body began to shake violently. I held her close

and cried with her—the way someone should have so many years ago.


I invited her to look around the memory and “find” God—after all, He is everywhere, all of the time. She immediately felt the Holy Spirit was surrounding her. I asked her what she would like the Holy Spirit to do and she cried out, “I need life put back in me!” Comforter wrapped His love around her like a warm, fuzzy blanket as He lifted her off of the table.

As He poured life into His little girl, she sobbed for over 30 minutes. The memories of that awful room that were trapped inside of her were being processed and healed. God spoke words of affirmation to her dead heart. His power flooded her physical body healing the pain in her neck and back.

I watched as God did what only He could do, what no one else had been able to do. At the end of our two hour session, Susie laughed so hard she cried, but this time they were tears of joy, freedom and relief.

The pain was finally gone and peace fill her heart. Susie said, “I feel alive for the first time in a very long time.”

I believe that *everything* in life is meant to lead us to God. That means our past, present and future should take us deeper into the heart of God, which will result in our walking into our destiny and purpose. As a child, I experienced physical and sexual abuse that nearly destroyed me spirit, soul and body...but for the grace of my God! I know how it feels, at a young age, to be used and abused sexually, but, thank God, I also know how it feels to experience the love and healing power of my heavenly Father who can put the most shattered life back together.

We thank God everyday for *Our Father's Farm*—a place where lost dreams can be found and shattered lives can be healed. God has clearly asked us to provide love and homes for girls who have been rescued from the horrible sex slave industry in America. We want to help as many girls as the Lord will send our way. When God first invited us to partner with Him in loving these little lambs, my response was, “God, I need to know that we have what it takes to be able to help these girls.”

Two weeks later, He sent us a 13 year old girl who had been devastated by sexual abuse at a young age. This precious girl had received professional counseling for 7 years, but she was basically non-functioning. I've never met anyone as fractured as she. To God's glory, in less than six months of living on Our Father's Farm, she is now functioning at a high level—she can eat, sleep, relate to others and go about her day without being paralyzed with fear or anxiety. She is in love with a very personal God. She now laughs, cries and feels every emotion. Her face and eyes beam with light and joy and energy!

After watching God heal her, I now know that, with God's help, we *can* bring healing to these shattered girls!

Now this is where you can help us. God has invited us to provide homes and families for girls rescued from the sex slave industry and for others—and we want to do exactly that! We have already purchased (debt-free) the exterior materials needed for a *30,000 sq. foot building*. Before Al Siemens, who has generously volunteered to erect the structure can begin, we need the finances for the road, water, electric and 10,000 sq. foot basement. All of that will cost approximately \$110,000.

Will you **please** ask God if you are to help us? Our team is praying diligently asking God to speak to *110* people who will donate at least *\$1000*, which will provide the necessary funds needed. We have a short window to build here due to our weather (May—Nov.) What will we use this building for? So glad you asked...

- Basement: multi-purpose room/storage
- Main Floor: 8 healing rooms, dorm for interns & others in need of intensive care, healing & discipleship, 300 person meeting room for seminars, church services, worship/prayer room and Apostolic Training School
- The crowing jewel is the third floor: This floor will be set aside for girls rescued from human trafficking and other children and women in crisis.
